

Special Pickups

Special pick-up service for certain items such as bags, tree limbs, large appliances (freon must be removed), carpet, furniture, tires (additional fees apply) and cardboard boxes may be arranged by calling **309-5750**. These items should be placed at the curb or alley for collection before calling for the special pick-up service. Limbs are to be cut small enough that one person can easily load the limbs. Wood cut or trimmed by professional tree services should be disposed of by the contractor. The contractor must dispose of material and debris including carpet generated by construction projects.

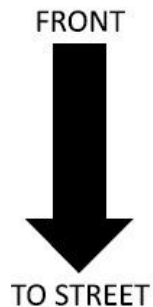
The rate for this service is \$26.25 minimum per call, not to exceed 15 minutes loading time. All time required for loading in excess of 15 minutes will be charged at a rate of \$26.25 for each one-half hour or portion thereof.

Non-City Sanitation customers (residential only) may call for a special pick-up. The rate for this service is \$52.50 minimum per call not to exceed 15 minutes loading time. All time required for loading in excess of 15 minutes will be charged at a rate of \$52.50 for each one-half hour or portion thereof.

Holiday Schedule

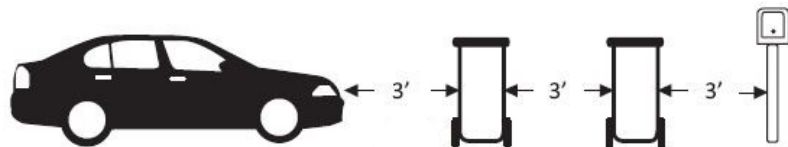
Sanitation crews operate Monday through Friday except Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. Following these holidays, routes will be completed one (1) day later.

Cart Setout

- No items outside the carts will be collected (items too large for the carts will require a special pickup).
- Carts must be placed within two (2) feet of the curb or alley with the arrow pointing towards the street or alley.
- Carts should be a minimum of three (3) feet from any obstructions in all directions (i.e. mailboxes, fences, trees, vehicles, poles, other carts, etc.).
- Carts blocked by vehicles or other obstructions will not be collected.
- Keep carts away from low-hanging branches or wires.
- Lids should be fully closed.
- Do not overfill carts as it may be too heavy to be picked up.
- Carts must be out by 7:00 a.m. on collection day.
- Do not leave the carts at the curb for more than 24 hours.
- Bagging refuse inside the carts, especially loose lightweight material that could scatter in the wind, will help reduce blowing refuse.

Additional Carts

Each additional cart costs \$2.00 per month.

Salina Drive-thru Recycling Center (SDRC):

The SDRC is a no-sort facility that accepts a wide variety of recyclable materials for all Salina and Saline County residents and small businesses.

Items that will be accepted include:

- Aluminum & steel (tin) beverage & food cans
- Cardboard & pasteboard (flatten for better use of space)
- Glass containers (all colors of food & beverage jars & bottles)
- Magazines, catalogs, junk mail, office paper and books
- Newspapers (including inserts)
- Plastic beverage, food and soap containers (plastics 1-6)
- *Shredded Paper - in separate bags (paper or clear plastic bags preferred)



Household Hazardous Waste (HHW):

We encourage the diversion of household hazardous (HHW) waste from the Landfill.

- Household hazardous waste is waste generated in the home that poses a serious health risk. These items may be flammable, toxic, reactive or corrosive.
- Items accepted include: household cleaners, pesticides, paint and paint products, antifreeze, engine and transmission oil, brake fluid, fluorescent light bulbs, propane tanks < 2 1/2 lbs. and similar products.
- Before bringing items to the facility, please make sure lids are tight and products are labeled (original labels preferred).
- Each participant will be limited to five (5) gallons of liquid or fifty (50) pounds of waste per visit.
- The facility only accepts residential household hazardous waste.

The Salina Municipal Solid Waste Landfill provides waste disposal in accordance with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE).

- Disposal fees are based on the type and weight of materials brought to the landfill. The minimum disposal fee at the landfill is \$11.00 per vehicle for loads up to 500 lbs. Loads of 500 lbs. or more will be \$44.00 per ton. There are separate fees for other materials such as tires, dirt, rock, concrete, asbestos, contaminated soil, etc. Please call for specific rates not listed.
- Saline county residents can bring their yard waste (brush, logs and stumps) free of charge.
- By state law, all loads entering the Landfill shall be covered or secured to prevent blowing and spilling litter during transportation.
- Closed on Sundays, Thanksgiving, Christmas, & New Year's Day.
- Early closure at 2:00 p.m. on Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.
